## Black Quill / Blue Quill



### Black Quill

Hook	#12 to 16 dry
Thread	black
Tail	black hackle fibers
Body	stripped black quill
Wings	dark gray mallard wing quill segments
Hackle	black
Tyer	John Bonasera



### Blue Quill

Hook	#12 to 16 dry
Thread	black
Tail	blue dun hackle fibers
Body	stripped gray peacock quill
Wings	slate gray mallard wing quill segments
Hackle	blue dun
Tyer	John Bonasera



### Hare's Ear Nymph

Hook	#12 to 16 Mustad 9671
Thread	black
Abdomen	hare's ear mask
Thorax	dark hare's ear mask
Wing case	brown mottled turkey
Tail	brown hackle
Rib	fine gold wire
Beard	brown hackle fibers (optional)
Tyer	Tony Coccozza
Note	<i>Many variations of this highly effective nymph</i>



### New American Nymph, Brown

Hook	#12 or 14 2x long curved nymph hook
Bead head	gold or copper (optional)
Thread	black
Tail	pheasant tail fibers
Abdomen	brown Larva Lace or similar stretch material
Thorax	peacock
Underwing	pearlescent tinsel, laid flat over peacock thorax
Wing	white Antron or Z-Ion
Collar	brown Generation X dubbing (Doug Swisher.com) or spikey brown hare's ear
Originator	Todd Spire (after D. Swisher)
Tyer	Todd Spire



### Mayfly Spinner (black)

Hook	#12 to 18 dry
Tail	2 or 3 fibbets, one and one-half the length of the body
Body	Sparse dubbing of black, thickening at thorax
Wing	White Antron or Zelon, tied splayed-wing style, over-dubbed, continue dubbing to head
Tyer	Mark Loete
