## Blue Wing Olive/Adams



**Blue Wing Olive**

Hook	#14 to 20 Daiichi 1180
Thread	white or olive
Tail	medium to dark dun hackle fibers
Body	olive yarn and muskrat fur blended
Wings	none
Hackle	medium dark dun over-sized one size
Originator	unknown
Tyer	Joe David



**Adams**

Hook	#10 to 20
Thread	black
Tail	brown and grizzly hackle fibers (gold tag optional)
Body	gray muskrat fur
Wing	grizzly hackle tips (tied spent-wing optional)
Hackle	brown and grizzly
Originator	Leonard Halliday, Michigan
Tyers	Roger Menard ( <i>Adams Spent Wing, Attractors page</i> ), Hank Rope ( <i>Adams Dry, Dry Fly page</i> )



**Pheasant Tail Nymph**

Hook	#12 to 18 nymph
Thread	brown
Tail	pheasant tail fibers
Abdomen	pheadant tail fibers
Rib	thin copper wire
Thorax	peacock herl
Wing case	pheasant tail fibers or mottled turkey quill, folded forward
Legs	picked out from the wing case
Originator	Frank Sawyer, England, from various traditional English patterns
Tyer	Tony Coccozza



**Mayfly Spinner (brown)**

Hook	#12 to 18 dry
Tail	2 or 3 fibbets, one and one-half the length of the body
Body	Sparse dubbing of brown, thickening at thorax
Wing	White Antron or Zelon, tied splayed-wing style, over-dubbed, continue dubbing to head
Tyer	Mark Loete



**Blue Wing Olive Loop-Wing Emerger**

Hook	#14 to 18 nymph
Thread	Olive
Tail	Blue dun hackle barbs
Body	Olive dubbing
Hackle	Blue dun
Wing	Gray Antron or Z-lon, tied in a loop
Originator	Andre Puyans, California
Tyer	Mark Loete
