## March Brown / Red Fox



### March Brown

Hook	#10 or 12 dry
Thread	orange
Tail	medium or dark ginger hackle fibers
Body	fawn colored fox fur or reddish tan equivalent
Wings	barred mallard or wood duck flank
Hackle	dark ginger and grizzly mixed
Originator	Preston Jennings, New York
Tyer	Roger Menard



### Red Fox

Hook	12 Mustad 94840
Thread	white
Body	buff and red belly fur of red fox
Wings	wood duck or mallard flank
Hackle	light ginger
Tail	wood duck
Originator	Ray Smith, New York
Tyer	Ed Ostapczuk



### Hare's Ear Nymph

Hook	12 Mustad 9671
Thread	black
Abdomen	hare's ear mask
Thorax	dark hare's ear mask
Wing case	brown mottled turkey
Tail	brown hackle
Rib	fine gold wire
Beard	brown hackle fibers (optional)
Tyer	Ed Ostapczuk
Note	Many variations of this highly effective nymph



### March Brown Wet

Hook	Mustad S80-3906 #12
Thread	Uni 8/0 Rusty Brown
Tail	bronze Mallard
Rib	flat Gold Tinsel
Body	hare's Ear Dubbing
Hackle	brown Partridge
Wing	hen Pheasant Wing Quill
Originator	traditional English pattern
Tyer	Bob Petti



### Mayfly Spinner (amber)

Hook	#12 to 18 dry
Tail	2 or 3 fibbets, one and one-half the length of the body
Body	sparse dubbing of dark amber, thickening at thorax
Wing	white Antron or Zelon, tied splayed-wing style, over-dubbed, continue dubbing to head
Tyer	Mark Loete
