Black Bear, Black Nose Dace, Mickey Finn



Black Bear

Hook	#6 to 10 nymph
Tail	red dyed deer hair
Weight	Lead wire, or equivalent (optional)
Body	black floss or yarn
Ribbing	copper wire
Wing	black bear fur
Originator	Ralph Hoffman, New York
Tyer	Ralph Hoffman

Black Nose Dace

Hook	Sealey SF5 #6 (3XL round bend)
Thread	Black
Tail	Red Wool, short
Weight	Lead wire, or equivalent (optional)
Body	Flat Silver Tinsel
Rib	Oval Silver Tinsel
Wing	A small bunch of white bucktail, over which is a small bunch of black bear hair, over which is a small bunch of brown bucktail. The black hair is a little shorter than the brown or the white.
Originator	Art Flick, New York
Tyer	Bob Petti
Note	Flick tied his Black Nose Dace bucktails on smaller hooks with the wing extending well beyond the bend, different from what would be considered typical bucktail style.

Mickey Finn

Hook	Mustad 3665A #6
Thread	Black
Weight	Lead wire, or equivalent (optional)
Body	Flat Silver Tinsel
Rib	Oval Silver Tinsel
Wing	A sparse bunch of yellow bucktail, over which is a sparse bunch of red bucktail, over which is a bunch of yellow bucktail equal in size to the first two bunches.

Tyer	Bob Petti
Notes	In dressing this fly correctly, it is important to note that the lower yellow band and the red band are the same size, but that the upper yellow band is twice the size of the lower.
